

Program Overview

The Smiling Hill Farm Summer Farm Program is designed for children ages 4 –14 to experience daily farm activities in a fun and educational setting. Participants will learn about the variety of animals present at the farm including: sheep, goats, dairy cattle, alpacas, chickens, ducks, and a variety of small animals.

Activities may include: making small animal houses, tools for enrichment, collecting eggs, and caring for the animals. Each day will have a specific animal focus and offer other fun activities throughout the week such as: arts, crafts, and games relating to the focus. For our older participants: assist in trimming goat hooves, prepare animal meals, monitor incubators, and create enrichment for small animals. On warm days children will have the option to choose running under the sprinkler or an arts & crafts activity.

The Barnyard is designed to be an outdoor experience with room to play, including wooden climbing structures and Mary-Ann the steam shovel. At the end of your visit, check out our Gift Shop, which is fully stocked with lots of farm and animal themed educational activities and toys. Our friendly staff is eager to assist you with your animal experience. We love sharing information about our history and animals.
